Every Storm Cloud has a Silver Lining

Last fall, Hurricane Igor reeked havoc here in Terra Nova National Park, however, in its wake, it has revealed an array of interesting archeological treasures! Last weekend a group of 10 visitors participated in a 2-day Public Archeology Dig with Archaeologist Jenneth Curtis, Archeology Assistant Allison Hudson and Aboriginal Interpreter Starlen Thistle. The team discovered a variety of objects exposed beneath the roots of large fallen trees and along the eroded shoreline. Artifacts ranging from Aboriginal projectiles (arrow head & skinning tool) to a 19th century plate, and much more. Participants reported that this first-time archaeology program was a resounding success. We hope to bring more programming like this to our visitors in the future.



We've been seeing a lot of bears along the highway in the park lately. If you are travelling through the park and see a bear please remember to pull your vehicle over to the side of the highway, inside the white line, and stay inside your vehicle. Also DO NOT feed the bears - stopping on the Trans Canada Highway to feed black bears puts the public and these animals at risk.
